Iconic, Milanese, and sophisticated, the 1963 wall lamp is a perfect balance of flowing lines, harmonious proportions, and refined materials. A timeless lighting design that embodies the elegance and optimism of Milan during the years of the economic boom—a period of extraordinary cultural, industrial, and creative vitality.

Originally designed in 1960, it was named 1963 because it was the 1,963rd serial-production lamp manufactured by Fontana Arte. Its structure, available in three elegant finishes—brass, brushed nickel, and black lacquer—highlights the purity of its form and the quality of its materials. Completing the design, two satin-finished white lattimo glass diffusers cast a soft, enveloping light, creating a warm and sophisticated atmosphere. A design icon that transcends time, preserving its enduring charm and contemporary appeal.



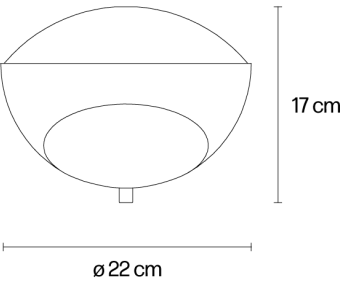

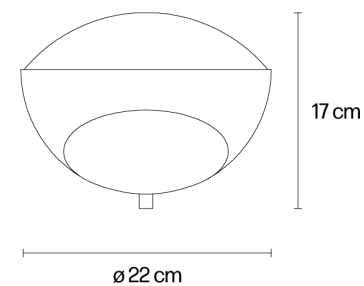
